

Key facts about pupil learning, teaching and school management in **Koinadugu District**




This factsheet is based on findings from the Secondary Grade Learning Assessment (2018).

Fact 1

In Koinadugu, learning levels of JSS2 and SSS2 pupils are low in both English and Mathematics.






Average learning levels in Koinadugu are lower than the national average


Fact 2

In Koinadugu, learning levels of JSS2 girls and boys are similar, but SSS2 girls score lower than SSS2 boys.



Fact 3

SSS2 Pupils from wealthier households perform better in English than pupils from poorer households in Koinadugu. However, in JSS schools, learning levels of wealthy and poor pupils are similar.

Fact 4

In Koinadugu, a small percentage of JSS and SSS teachers are female. Most teacher characteristics in Koinadugu are similar to the national average statistics.

Fact 7

86% of JSS teachers now use printed MBSSE lesson plans in Koinadugu. However, 62% of these teachers find it difficult to link learning objectives to the appropriate grade level.



9 in every 10 JSS teachers use printed MBSSE lesson plans in Koinadugu 6 out of 10 JSS teachers that use lesson plans in Koinadugu are unable to link learning objectives to the appropriate grade level



In Koinadugu, a similar fraction of teachers make the right links, as at the national level, where only 4 in 10 teachers are able to do so

Fact 6

A typical JSS school in Koinadugu has 23 pupils per teacher. The pupil-teacher ratio is similar in JSS and SSS schools.

Lesson observations in Koinadugu are conducted in most schools.

Fact 8

Nearly all schools have parent-teacher or community-teacher associations in Koinadugu. Most of these bodies are active, having met at-least once in the current or previous term.
