# What is the School Leadership Programme?

Qualified, capable, professional leaders are vital to our schools. They support teachers to develop skills, inspire improved outcomes, and enable learners to achieve their potential.

So, the Teaching Service Commission is excited to offer Sierra Leone's first ever School Leadership Programme.

The programme's Core Course builds knowledge, skills and values that will enable you to assess your school's needs and make critical improvements to safety, inclusion, teaching and learning.

The course is currently free and will run from April 2024 to March 2025. It comprises three modules:



## Module one

School safety and inclusion



## Module two

Leading teaching and learning



## Module three

Creating a School Improvement Plan

Each module requires self-study, practical assignments and continuous assessment. Your learning is supported by printed materials, video and online resources and experienced school leaders.

# Who can apply?

The Core Course in the School Leadership Programme is open to applicants who can demonstrate the following:

- Currently in a Principal, Vice Principal, Senior Teacher or Head of Department role.
- Engagement in personal professional development and supported other teachers' professional development.
- Commitment to inclusion and school safety and improving learning.
- Basic digital skills (i.e. can use a smartphone or tablet, including sending/receiving messages, photos and video, and using websites).
- Willingness to study for up to 5 hours per week.
